1. Cookies

Cookies are small text files placed on your device (computer, phone, or tablet) when you visit the Website. They are widely used to enable the Website functionality, improve performance and user experience, and provide information to Website operators.

Cookies can:

- Be first-party cookies, which are set directly by our Website, or third-party cookies, which are set by third-party services that we use (such as analytics or advertising providers);
- Be session cookies, which are temporary and are deleted when you close your browser;
- Or persistent cookies, which remain on your device for a defined period or until you delete them.

2. Types of Cookies We Use

We use both essential and optional cookies on this Website. An overview is provided below:

a) Essential Cookies:

- These cookies are essential for the proper functioning of the Website and enable core features such as security, user authentication and page navigation.
- As these cookies are strictly necessary for the operation of the Website, they do not require your consent.
- Without these cookies, some parts of the Website may not function properly.

b) Optional Cookies: We use optional cookies only with your consent, unless otherwise permitted by applicable law. These cookies are not strictly necessary but help us improve your experience.

- **Performance & Functional Cookies:** These cookies remember your preferences (such as language or login settings) and enhance usability and functionality.
- **Analytics Cookies:** These cookies collect information about how users interact with the Website, such as pages visited, time spent and links clicked. This information is typically aggregated and anonymized and is used to improve the performance and effectiveness of the Website.
- **Advertising and Targeting Cookies:** These cookies are used to deliver more relevant advertisements and content based on your interests, as well as to measure and improve the effectiveness of marketing campaigns.

3. Cookie Duration

We are committed to implementing responsible cookie storage practices to ensure your privacy and improve your browsing experience. Below, we describe the various categories of cookies we use and the duration for which each is stored:

(a) Session Cookies

Session cookies are temporary cookies that are automatically removed once you close your browser. They are used to manage and preserve your active session during your visit, enabling smooth and secure navigation across the Website. These cookies allow us to remember your actions as you move between pages, so you can use the Website efficiently without the need to repeatedly re-authenticate.

(b) Persistent Cookies

Persistent cookies remain on your device for a specified period, even after you close your browser. These cookies remember your preferences and login details across multiple visits, making your experience more convenient and personalized. We typically limit the storage duration of these cookies up to a maximum of 24 months. This means that after this period, the cookies will automatically expire and be deleted from your device.

By using both session and persistent cookies, we aim to provide you with a smooth and personalized browsing experience while also respecting your privacy and data security.
